

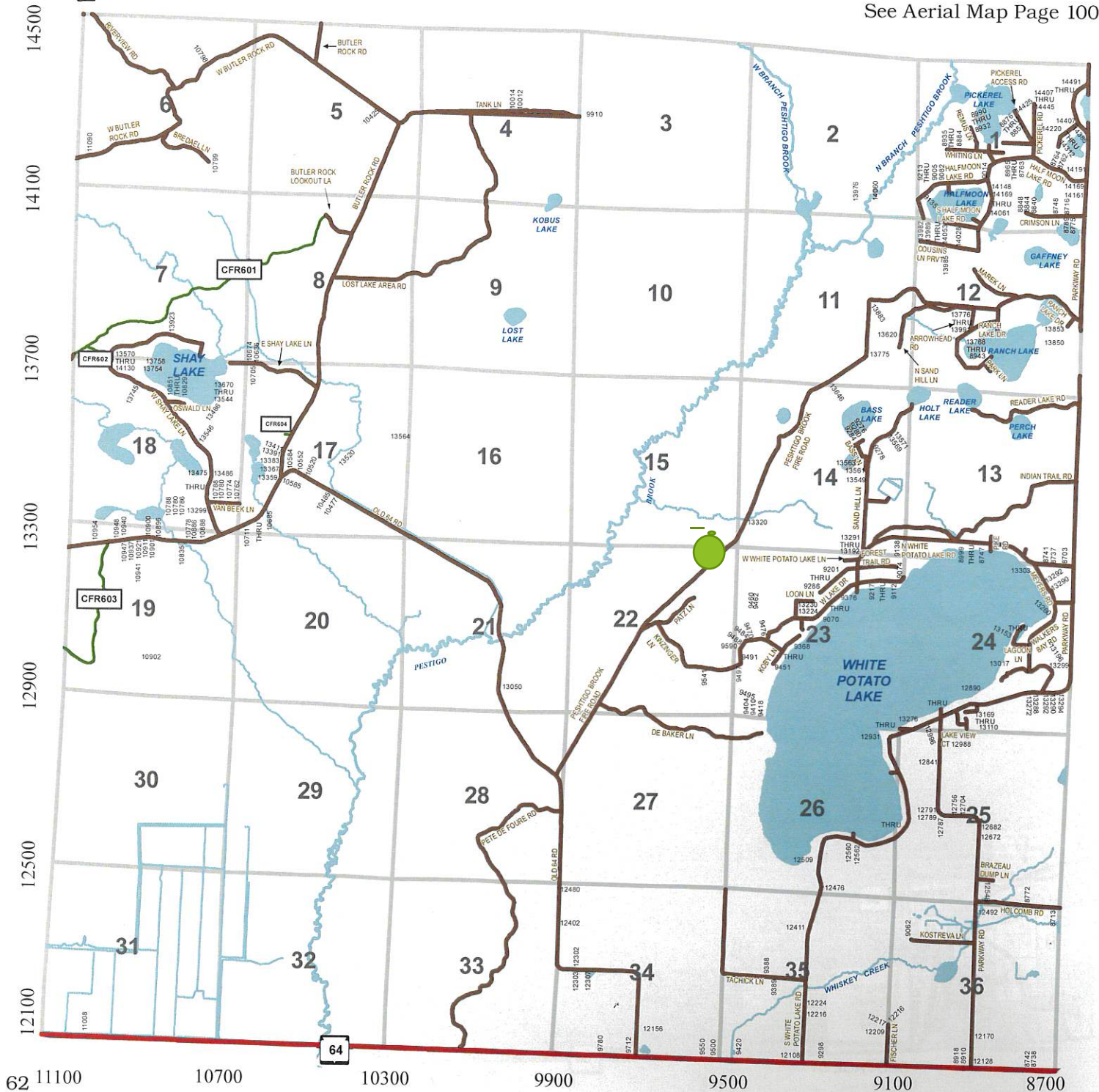

# 401-25



Overstory Removal (13 acres): Harvest all merchantable trees EXCEPT green-marked trees & Hemlock; cut orange-marked Hemlock. Limit damage to existing Oak <5".



Pine Thinning (2 acres): Harvest orange-marked Pine, Oak & all other trees >5". DO NOT cut unmarked Oak



Coppice Harvest (35 acres): Cut only orange-marked Oak & conifers. Cut all Balsam Fir & all other trees >1"



Shelterwood Harvest (12 acres): Cut all trees >1" diameter except white pine, hemlock, cedar, & green painted trees. Leave all oak <4". Sever any oak saplings damaged during harvest operations.

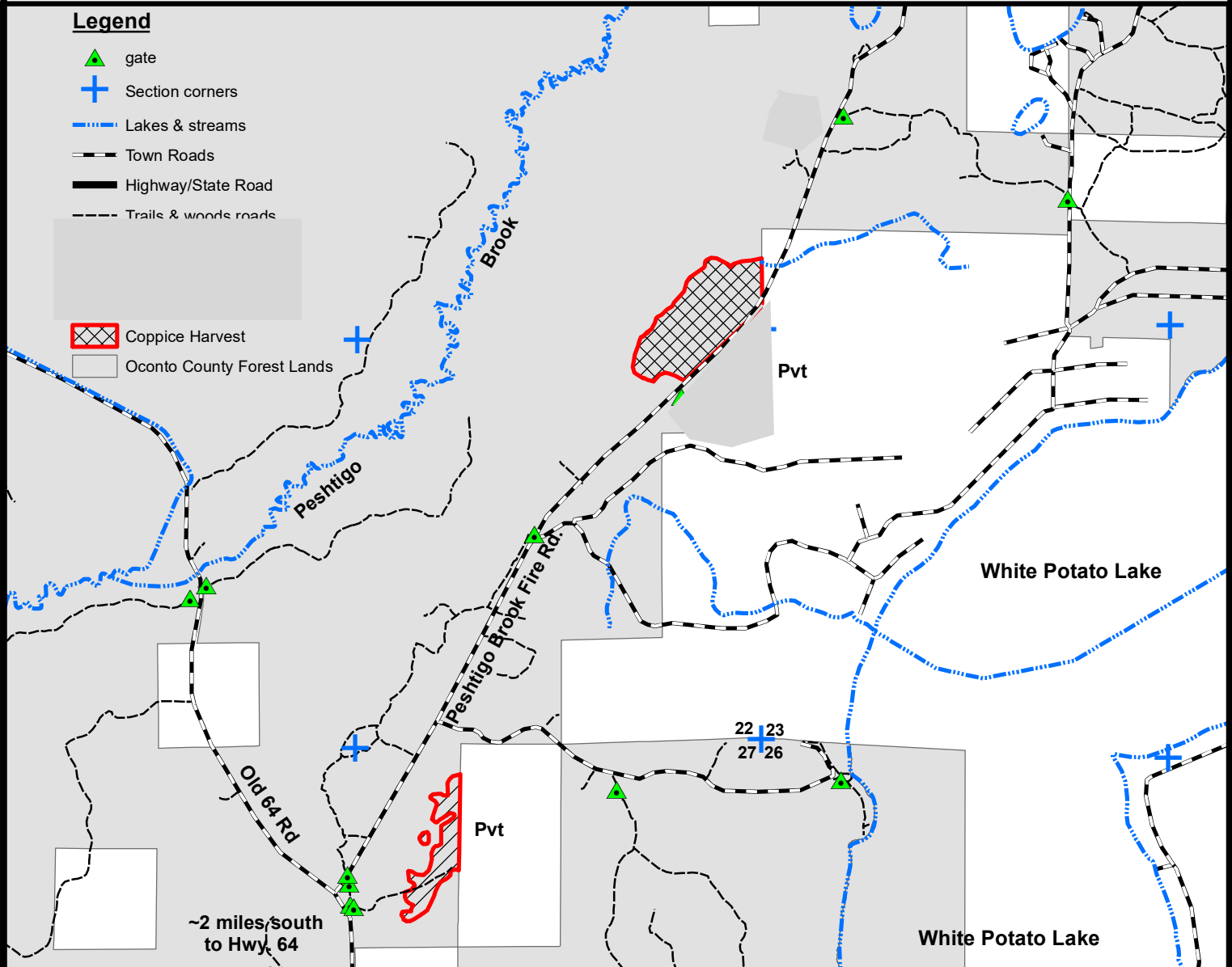
